1. Nature of the Event

Project Europa 2026 is a free to enter travel inspiration experience. It is not a guided tour, organised transport service, or supervised race.

Participants are provided with a series of checkpoints for inspiration only. There is no requirement to visit all checkpoints, and participants take part entirely at their own discretion.

2. Voluntary Participation

All participation is entirely voluntary.

By taking part, participants acknowledge that they choose if, when, and how to travel to any checkpoint, they are solely responsible for planning their routes, transport, accommodation, and logistics, and they may stop participation at any time without notice.

3. Personal Responsibility and Safety

Participants are fully responsible for their own safety, wellbeing, and decision making at all times.

This includes assessing travel risks and conditions, complying with all local laws and regulations, ensuring they are physically and medically fit to travel, and making appropriate arrangements for insurance, visas, and documentation.

Participants must act responsibly and safely at all times when travelling to or visiting checkpoints.

4. No Liability for Travel

Lupine Racing does not organise, manage, or supervise participant travel.

Lupine Racing accepts no responsibility for any journeys undertaken and is not liable for any injury, loss, delay, damage, or expense incurred. All travel to and from checkpoints is undertaken entirely at the participant's own risk.

This applies regardless of whether checkpoints are suggested, recommended, or listed as part of the event.

5. Checkpoints and Routes

Checkpoints are provided for inspiration only.

Participants are not required to visit checkpoints in any specific order, may choose their own routes and methods of travel, and must independently assess the suitability and safety of each checkpoint.

Lupine Racing makes no guarantees regarding accessibility, safety, or availability of any checkpoint.

6. Leaderboard and Check In Data

Participants may submit check ins at checkpoints to appear on event leaderboards.

By doing so, participants agree that their submitted check in data will be collected and processed, and that this data is used solely to facilitate live leaderboards and event engagement.

8. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, participants agree that they take part entirely at their own risk and that Lupine Racing is not responsible for any personal injury, illness, loss, damage, or expense. Lupine Racing has no duty of care in relation to participant travel or activities.

9. Acceptance of Terms

By participating in Project Europa 2026, participants confirm that they have read and understood these Terms and Conditions, accept full responsibility for their actions and travel decisions, and agree to participate at their own risk.
